


# USLNG Exports: Sept. 2020

- USLNG exports continued their recovery except for Cameron LNG that was unable to export due to a prolonged power outage from Hurricane Laura.


## TOP DESTINATIONS (SEPT)

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
## VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- Total exports of 110.2 bcf
- 37.1% more than Aug. 2020
- 6.5% less than Sept. 2019

## CARGOES EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- 45 Cargoes (+9 from Aug.) 6 Terminals
- 18 - Sabine Pass (+10 from Aug.)
- 11 - Corpus Christi (+6 from Aug.)
- 10 - Freeport (+6 from Aug.)
- 5 - Cove Point (unchanged)
- 1 - Elba Island (-1 from Aug.)
- 0 - Cameron (-11 from Aug.)


## Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months

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
## Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
