

USLNG Exports: Nov. 2020



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (NOV.)


- USLNG shipments increased dramatically month-over-month as Asian buyers stepped up purchasers
- Brazil emerged as a strong buyer, but no other Latin American or Middle Eastern buyer broke into the top dozen.

- Middle East, 0 bcf (0%)




VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- Total exports of 280.6 bcf
- 26.0% more than Oct. 2020
- 47.3% more than Nov. 2019

- 2 - Elba Island (unchanged)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
