


USLNG Exports: Dec. 2020



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (DEC.)


- Top five destinations remained unchanged from Nov. 2020.
- Both Lithuania and Poland broke into top 12 USLNG destinations in the same month

- Asia, 161.9 bcf (53.2%)

- Middle East, 0 bcf (0%)




VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 8.4% more than Nov. 2020
- 38.1% more than Dec. 2019

- 3 - Elba Island (+1 from Nov.)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months

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
Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
