


USLNG Exports: Feb. 2021

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MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (FEB.)

- USLNG exports fell by nearly one third during February as a result of market conditions and liquefaction interruptions due to unseasonable weather. More than half of all cargoes landed in Europe.



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
VOLUME EXPORTED (28 DAYS)

- 6.2% less than Feb. 2020

- 4 - Elba Island (+4 from Jan.)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
