


USLNG Exports: March 2021

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MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (MARCH)

- USLNG exports rebounded significantly in March based upon strong demand in Asia and Europe where gas consumers replenished storage.


TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (MARCH)

- So. Korea (32.2 bcf)
- France (30.3 bcf)
- China (28.5 bcf)
- Japan (27.7 bcf)
- Netherlands (24.2 bcf)

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (MARCH)

- Americas, 56.8 bcf (17.9%)
- Asia, 129.5 bcf (40.8%)
- Europe, 124.6 bcf (39.2%)
- Middle East, 6.6 bcf (2.1%)

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
VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 311.6 bcf
- 30.6% less than Feb. 2021
- 6.2% less than March 2020

CARGOES EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 96 Cargoes (+31 from Feb. 2021)
- 35 - Sabine Pass (+10 from Feb.)
- 19 - Corpus Christi (+8 from Feb.)
- 19 - Freeport (+10 from Feb.)
- 15 - Cameron (+4 from Feb.)
- 7 - Cove Point (+2 from Feb.)
- 1 - Elba Island (-3 from Feb.)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months

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
Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
