


USLNG Exports: April 2021

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MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (APRIL)

- USLNG exports to China increased dramatically from March. (It is now estimated that China has surpassed Japan as world's leading LNG importer.)


TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (APRIL)

- China (46.8 bcf)
- France (36.1 bcf)
- Japan (28.8 bcf)
- Spain (23.0 bcf)
- So. Korea (21.7 bcf)

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (APRIL)

- Americas, 32.6 bcf (10.6%)
- Asia, 145.7 bcf (47.5%)
- Europe, 121.3 bcf (39.6%)
- Middle East, 6.9 bcf (2.3%)

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
VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- Total exports of 306.7 bcf
- 3.4% less than March 2021
- 45.8% more than April 2020

CARGOES EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- 92 Cargoes (- 4 from March 2021)
- 32 - Sabine Pass (-3 from March)
- 19 - Freeport (unchanged)
- 18 - Corpus Christi (-1 from March)
- 15 - Cameron (unchanged)
- 5 - Cove Point (-2 from March)
- 3 - Elba Island (+2 from March)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
