


# USLNG Exports: May 2021



## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (MAY)


- USLNG exports in May approached the record of March 2021. Asian destinations again dominated, but So. American demand was also quite significant.

## TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (MAY)

- So. Korea (46.6 bcf)
- China (37.7 bcf)
- India (28.3 bcf)
- Netherlands (26.6 bcf)
- Japan (25.1 bcf)

## REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (MAY)

- Americas, 63.5 bcf (15.4%)
- Asia, 161.3 bcf (50.7%)
- Europe, 90.0 bcf (32.1%)
- Middle East, 0.0 bcf (0.0%)




## VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 314.8 bcf
- 2.6% more than April 2021
- 72.7% more than May 2020

## CARGOES EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 103 Cargoes (+11 from April 2021)
- 35 - Sabine Pass (+3 from April)
- 21 - Freeport (+2 from April)
- 19 - Corpus Christi (+1 from April)
- 18 - Cameron (+3 from April)
- 7 - Cove Point (+2 from April)
- 3 - Elba Island (unchanged)


## Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
