


USLNG Exports: August 2021



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (AUG.)


- USLNG exports remained high at nearly 300 bcf in August with Asia and S. America leading Europe. China rose to the top spot, eclipsing S. Korea. Japan dropped to sixth.

TOP 5 DESTINATIONS (AUG.)

- China (51.7 bcf)
- S. Korea (50.1 bcf)
- Brazil (34.2 bcf)
- Spain (23.1)
- India (20.6)

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN (AUG.)

- Americas, 75.9 bcf (25.5%)
- Asia, 163.2 bcf (54.8%)
- Europe, 55.6 bcf (18.6%)
- Middle East, 3.3 bcf (1.1%)




VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 298.0 bcf
- 0.7% less than July 2021
- 170.5% more than Aug. 2020

CARGOES EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- 98 Cargoes (+1 from July 2021)
- 32 - Sabine Pass (+3 from July)
- 23 - Freeport (+2 from July)
- 19 - Corpus Christi (-2 from July)

- 3 - Elba Island (+1 from July)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
