


USLNG Exports: Nov. 2021



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (NOV.)


- USLNG exports to Europe grew dramatically in Nov. and exports to Asia and Americas declined.

- Asia, 139.8 bcf (45.7%)
- Europe, 149.1 bcf (48.7%)
- Middle East, 0 bcf (0%)




VOLUME EXPORTED (30 DAYS)

- 2 - Elba Island (-1 from Oct.)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months
