


USLNG Exports: Dec. 2021



MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS (DEC.)


- USLNG exports to Europe grew tremendously in Dec. with four of the five top destinations on the continent and 60% of cargoes unloaded there.

- Turkey (38.4 bcf)
- S. Korea (38.2 bcf)
- France (33.9 bcf)
- Spain (32.6 bcf)

- Asia, 96.0 bcf (27.8%)
- Europe, 149.1 bcf (60.1%)
- Middle East, 0 bcf (0%)




VOLUME EXPORTED (31 DAYS)

- Total exports of 345.0 bcf
- 12.7% more than Nov. 2021
- 13.4% more than Nov. 2020

- 3 - Elba Island (+1 from Nov.)


Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months


Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
