


# USLNG Exports: Sept. 2022

- Cameron tied with Sabine Pass for the largest number of cargoes.


## TOP 5 DESTINATIONS

- Spain (24.7 bcf)
- So. Korea (19.7 bcf)

## VOLUME EXPORTED

- **Total exports of 295.1 bcf**
- 1.6% less than Aug. 2022
- 3.7% more than Sept. 2021

## Top USLNG Destinations - Past 12 Months






## Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months


## USLNG Exports by Facility - Past 12 Months


## USLNG Shipments to Europe - Past 12 Months


## Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
