

- Freeport LNG continued its ramp up in return to service.


TOP 5 DESTINATIONS

Top USLNG Destinations - Past 12 Months






Regional Distribution of USLNG - Past 12 Months


USLNG Exports by Facility - Past 12 Months


USLNG Shipments to Europe - Past 12 Months


Top 15 Importers of USLNG - Since Feb. 2016
