

USLNG Exports: June 2023





MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- Will all seven USLNG liquefaction plants in operation, Q2-23 was the strongest quarter on record, surpassing Q1-22 and Q1-23.
- June cargoes were down 10.6% from May and went to a diverse swath of nations, including China and Kuwait.
