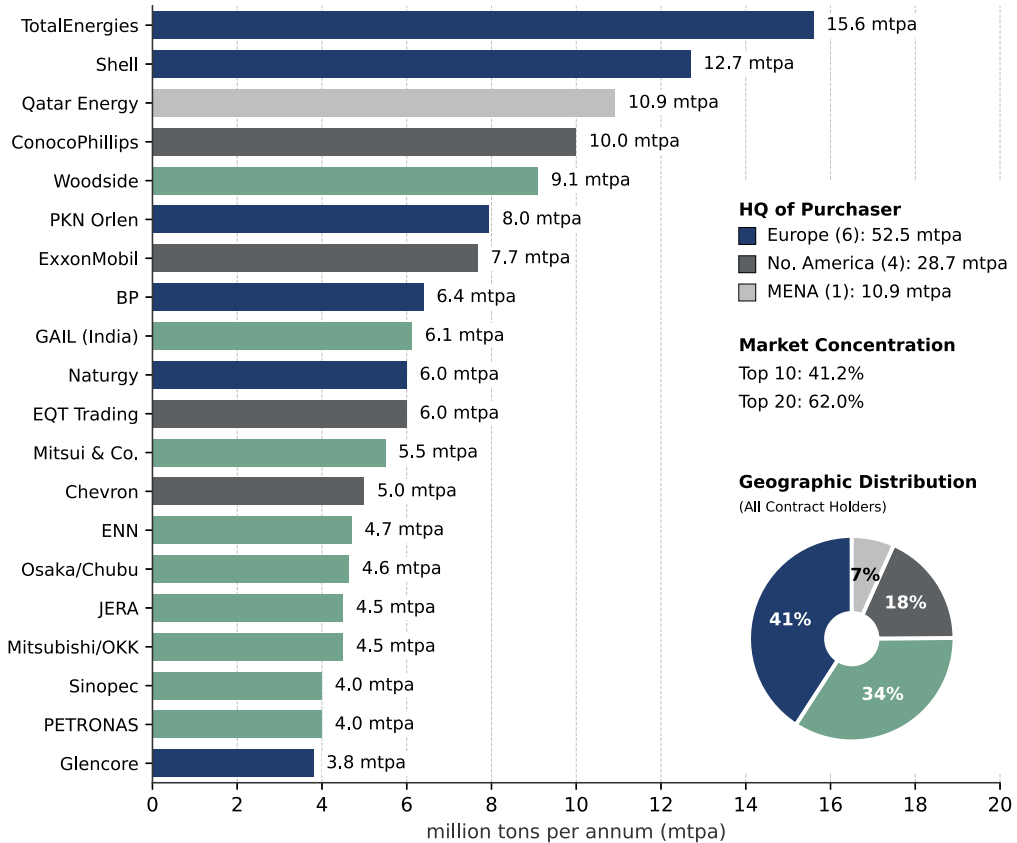

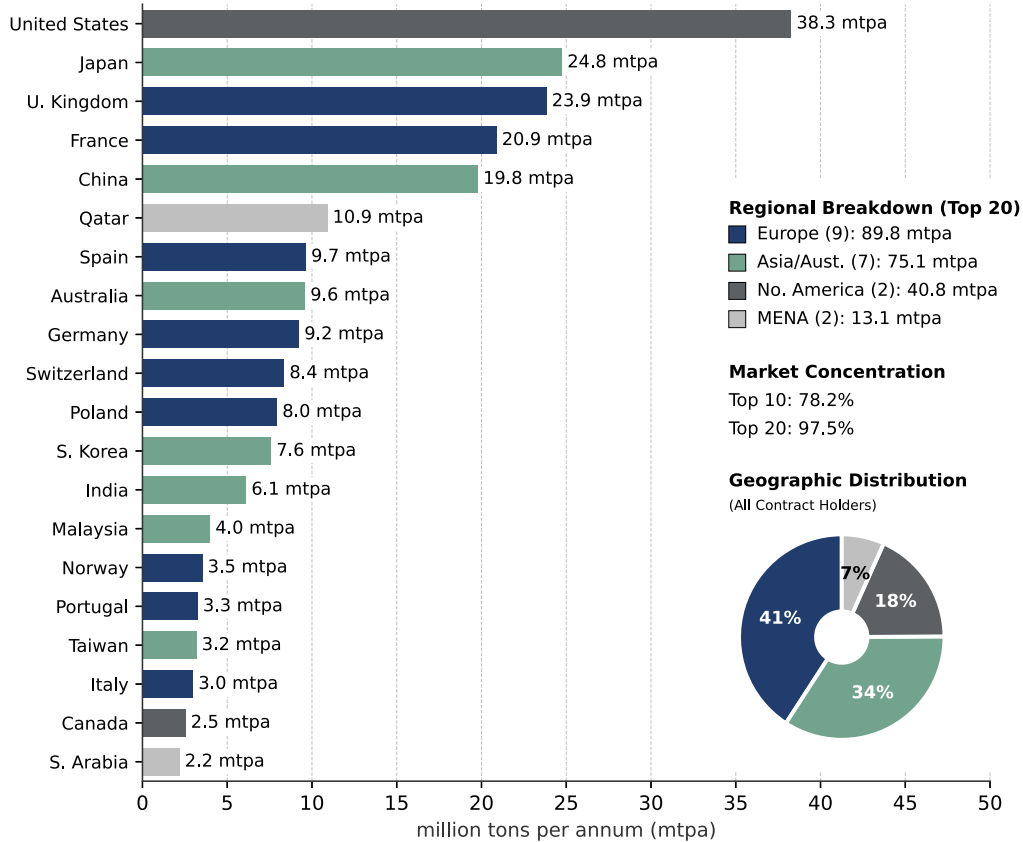

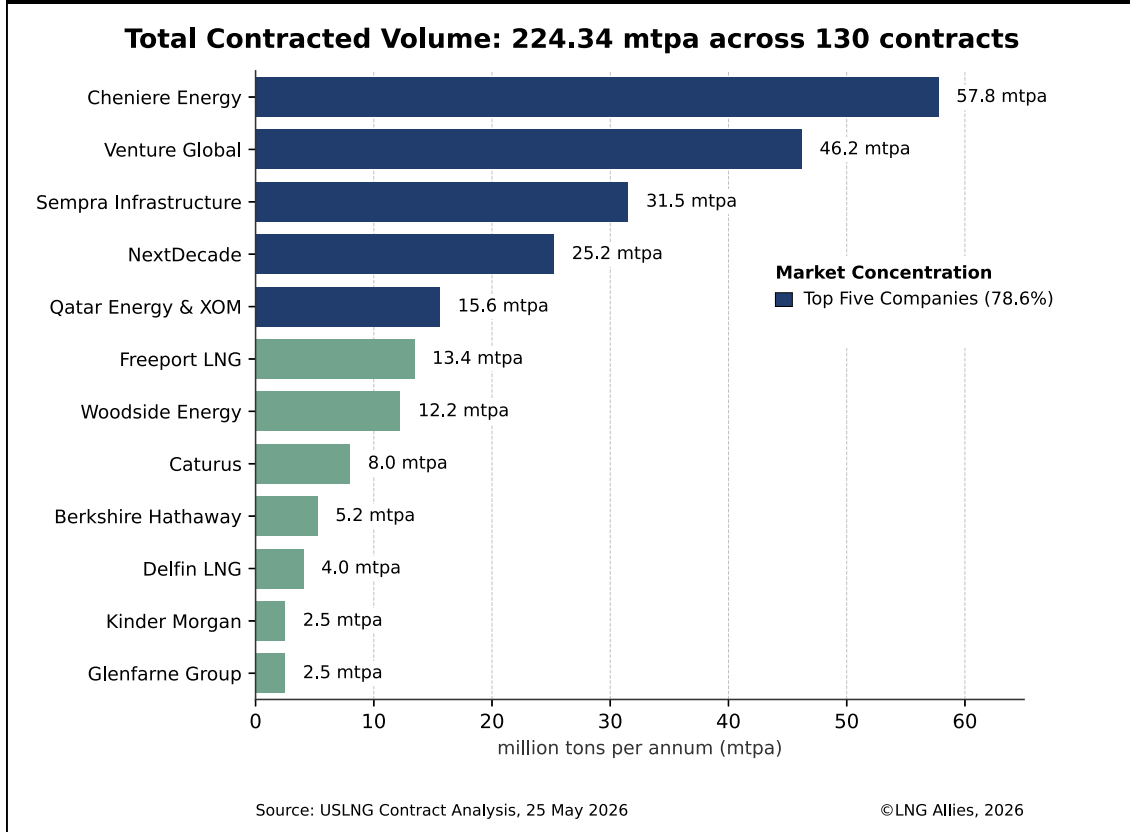

## Key Insights

### Contract Concentration

- The top 10 purchasers control 41.2% of total contracted volume.
- The top 20 purchasers control 62.0% of total contracted volume.
- Average contract size is 1.73 mtpa, with individual contracts ranging from 0.40 to 15.60 mtpa.
- Average contracted volume per company is 3.12 mtpa, reflecting a broad base of purchasers with significant volume diversity.

### Contract Signing Trends

- 2022 was the peak signing year by volume with 55.18 mtpa (24.6% of total volume) across 33 contracts.
- The period from 2022 to 2026 accounts for 55.8% of total contracted volume (125.28 mtpa) across 82 contracts, reflecting a sustained surge in USLNG contracting activity.
- Contracts signed in 2025 and 2026 represent 17.5% of total volume (39.35 mtpa) across 31 contracts, indicating continued strong momentum in new USLNG offtake agreements.
- Earlier contracting periods from 2011 to 2014 established foundational volumes, particularly through Sabine Pass and other first-mover projects.

### Geographic Distribution

- Europe (including Turkey) leads with 91.64 mtpa (40.8% of total volume), driven by energy security diversification and the transition away from pipeline gas dependence.
- Asia-Pacific accounts for 76.85 mtpa (34.3%), with Japan, China, and South Korea as the primary importing nations in the region.
- North America represents 40.83 mtpa (18.2%), with US-based companies and Canadian importers holding significant contracted volumes.

- The Middle East accounts for 15.02 mtpa (6.7%), primarily through Qatar Energy's contracted position at the Golden Pass project.

### Export Project Market Leaders

- Cheniere Energy first with 57.77 mtpa (25.8% of market).
- Venture Global second with 46.20 mtpa (20.6% of market).
- Sempra Infrastructure third with 31.53 mtpa (14.1% of market).
- NextDecade fourth with 25.25 mtpa (11.3% of market).
- Qatar Energy & ExxonMobil fifth with 15.60 mtpa (7.0% of market).
- Top Five Companies control 78.6% of total volume.

### Market Dynamics

- Integrated oil majors and large national oil companies account for a substantial share of total contracted volume, reflecting the strategic importance of long-term USLNG supply security for large energy portfolios.
- Trading companies and commodity merchants have increased their participation, particularly in contracts signed from 2022 onward, adding flexibility and liquidity to global LNG supply chains.
- Electric utilities and gas distribution companies represent a significant and growing segment of purchasers, driven by decarbonization targets and fuel-switching from coal to gas-fired generation.
- Independent LNG purchasers and portfolio players have expanded their contracted positions, with several companies holding contracts across multiple USLNG export facilities to diversify supply risk.
- The continued growth of new entrant purchasers from 2022 to 2026 reflects broadening market access and increasing confidence in USLNG project delivery timelines.
